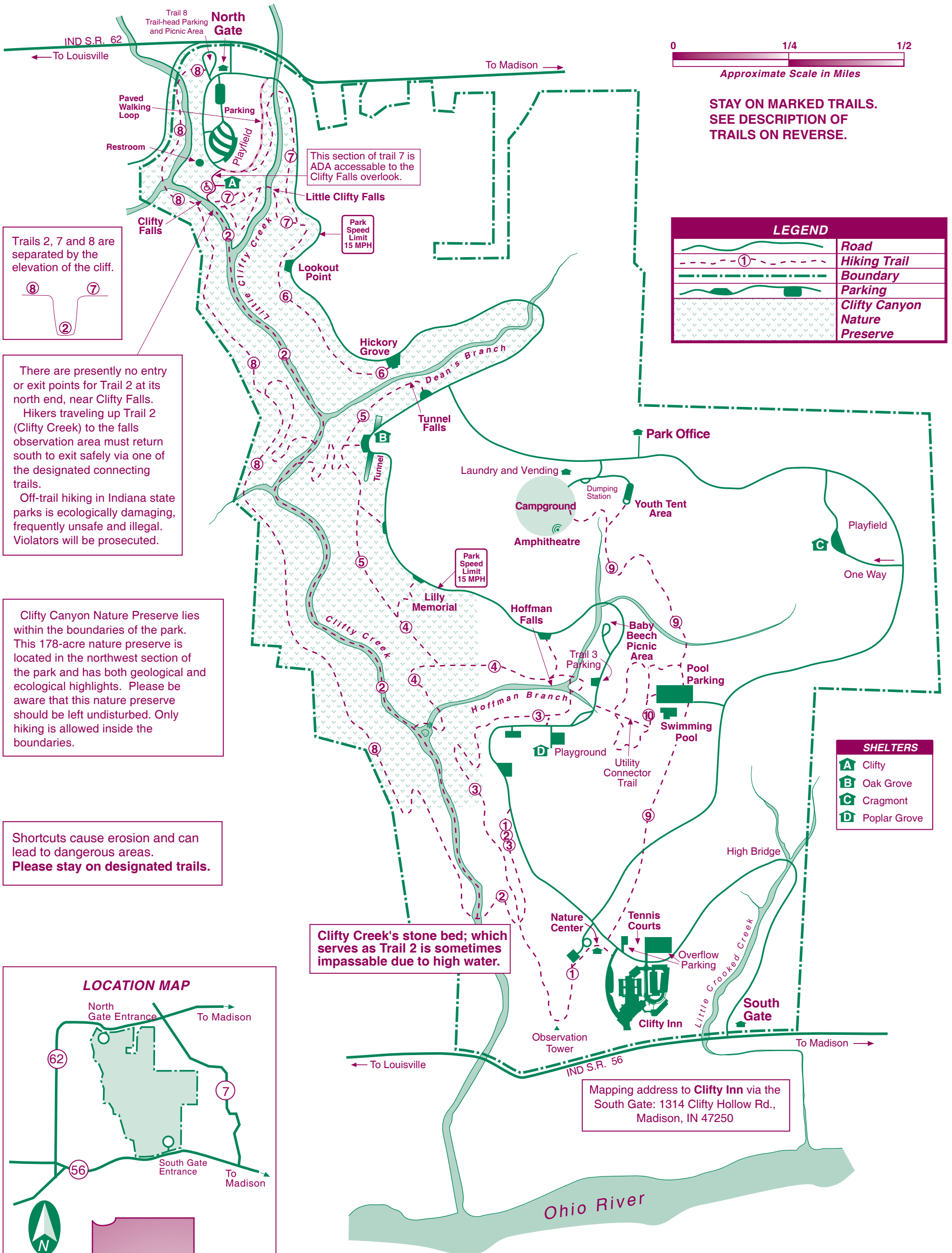

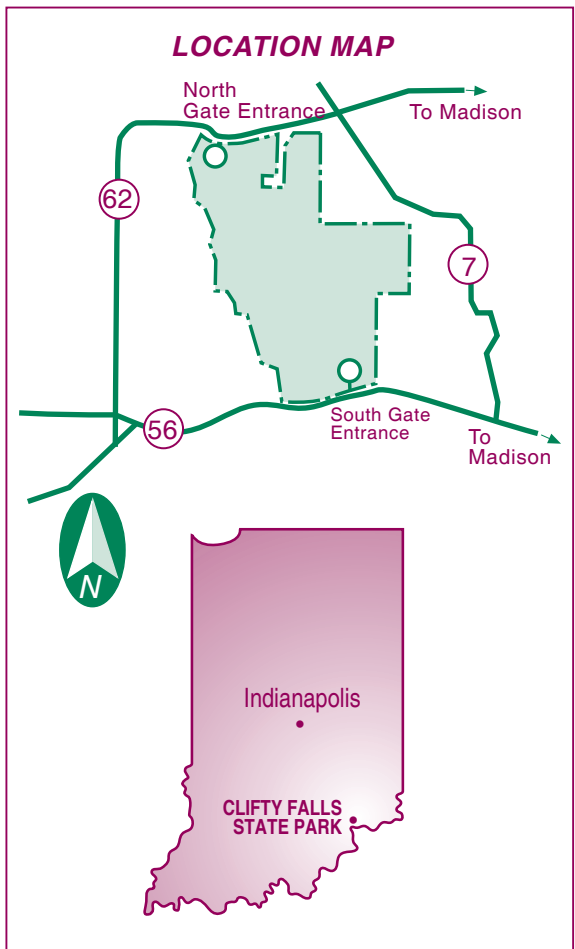

Trails 2, 7 and 8 are separated by the elevation of the cliff.

There are presently no entry or exit points for Trail 2 at its north end, near Clifty Falls. Hikers traveling up Trail 2 (Clifty Creek) to the falls observation area must return south to exit safely via one of the designated connecting trails. Off-trail hiking in Indiana state parks is ecologically damaging, frequently unsafe and illegal. Violators will be prosecuted.

Clifty Canyon Nature Preserve lies within the boundaries of the park. This 178-acre nature preserve is located in the northwest section of the park and has both geological and ecological highlights. Please be aware that this nature preserve should be left undisturbed. Only hiking is allowed inside the boundaries.

Shortcuts cause erosion and can lead to dangerous areas. **Please stay on designated trails.**
