

## 2017-2018 School Year School Entry Immunization Requirements

Below are the number of doses and each vaccine required for school entry. Changes for this year include the Hepatitis A vaccine requirement for grades K–3.

<b>3 to 5 years old</b>	3 Hep B (Hepatitis B) 4 DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus & Pertussis) 3 Polio (Inactivated Polio) 1 MMR (Measles, Mumps & Rubella) 1 Varicella (Chickenpox)	
<b>K-3rd grade</b>	3 Hep B 5 DTaP 4 Polio	2 MMR 2 Varicella 2 Hep A (Hepatitis A)
<b>Grades 4 to 5</b>	3 Hep B 5 DTaP 4 Polio	2 MMR 2 Varicella 2 Hep A*
<b>Grades 6 to 11</b>	3 Hep B 5 DTaP 4 Polio 1 Tdap (Tetanus & Pertussis)	2 MMR 2 Varicella 2 Hep A* 1 MCV4 (Meningococcal A, C, W <sup>135</sup> , Y)
<b>Grade 12</b>	3 Hep B 5 DTaP 4 Polio 1 Tdap	2 MMR 2 Varicella 2 Hep A* 2 MCV4 (Meningococcal) 2 MenB (Meningococcal B)**

**Hep B:** The minimum age for the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose of Hepatitis B is 24 weeks of age.

**DTaP:** 4 doses of DTaP/DTP/DT are acceptable if 4<sup>th</sup> dose was administered on or after child's 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.

**Polio:**

- 3 doses of Polio are acceptable for all grade levels if the third dose was given on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday and at least 6 months after the previous dose with only one type of vaccine used (all OPV or all IPV).
- For students in grades K-7<sup>th</sup> grade, the final dose must be administered on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday and be administered **at least 6 months** after the previous dose.

**Varicella:** Physician documentation of disease history, including month and year, is proof of immunity for children entering preschool through 9<sup>th</sup> grade. Parental report of disease history is acceptable for grades 10-12.

**Tdap:** There is no minimum interval from the last Td dose.

**MCV4 :** Individuals who receive dose 1 after their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday only need 1 dose of MCV4.

**Hep A:**

- The minimum interval between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose is 6 calendar months.
- For grades K-3, 2 doses are required.

\*For grades 4-12, 2 doses of Hep A are recommended.

**MenB** \*\*For grade 12, 2 doses of Meningococcal Serogroup B vaccine are recommended.

## 2018-2019 School Year (Proposed) School Entry Immunization Requirements

Below are the number of doses and each vaccine required for school entry. Changes for this year include the Hepatitis A vaccine requirement for grades K—4, 6 and 12 and Meningococcal Serogroup B vaccine for 12th grade.

<b>3 to 5 years old</b>	3 Hep B (Hepatitis B) 4 DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus & Pertussis) 3 Polio (Inactivated Polio) 1 MMR (Measles, Mumps & Rubella) 1 Varicella (Chickenpox)	
<b>K–4th grade</b>	3 Hep B 5 DTaP 4 Polio	2 MMR 2 Varicella 2 Hep A (Hepatitis A)
<b>Grade 5</b>	3 Hep B 5 DTaP 4 Polio	2 MMR 2 Varicella 2 Hep A*
<b>Grade 6</b>	3 Hep B 5 DTaP 4 Polio 1 Tdap (Tetanus & Pertussis)	2 MMR 2 Varicella 2 Hep A 1 MCV4 (Meningococcal)
<b>Grades 7 to 11</b>	3 Hep B 5 DTaP 4 Polio 1 Tdap (Tetanus & Pertussis)	2 MMR 2 Varicella 2 Hep A* 1 MCV4 (Meningococcal)
<b>Grade 12</b>	3 Hep B 5 DTaP 4 Polio 1 Tdap (Tetanus & Pertussis)	2 MMR 2 Varicella 2 Hep A 2 MCV4 (Meningococcal) 2 MenB (Meningococcal B)

**Hep B:** The minimum age for the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose of Hepatitis B is 24 weeks of age.

**DTaP:** 4 doses of DTaP/DTP/DT are acceptable if 4<sup>th</sup> dose was administered on or after child's 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.

**Polio:**

- 3 doses of Polio are acceptable for all grade levels if the third dose was given on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday and at least 6 months after the previous dose with only one type of vaccine used (all OPV or all IPV).
- For students in grades K-8<sup>th</sup> grade, the final dose must be administered on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday and be administered **at least 6 months** after the previous dose.

**Varicella:** Physician documentation of disease history, including month and year, is proof of immunity for children entering preschool through 10<sup>th</sup> grade. Parental report of disease history is acceptable for grades 11-12.

**Tdap:** There is no minimum interval from the last Td dose.

**MCV4 :** Individuals who receive dose 1 after their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday only need 1 dose of MCV4.

**Hep A** The minimum interval between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose is 6 calendar months. 2 doses of Hep A is required for grades K-4, 6 and 12.

\*For grades 5, and 7-11, 2 doses of Hep A vaccine are recommended .
