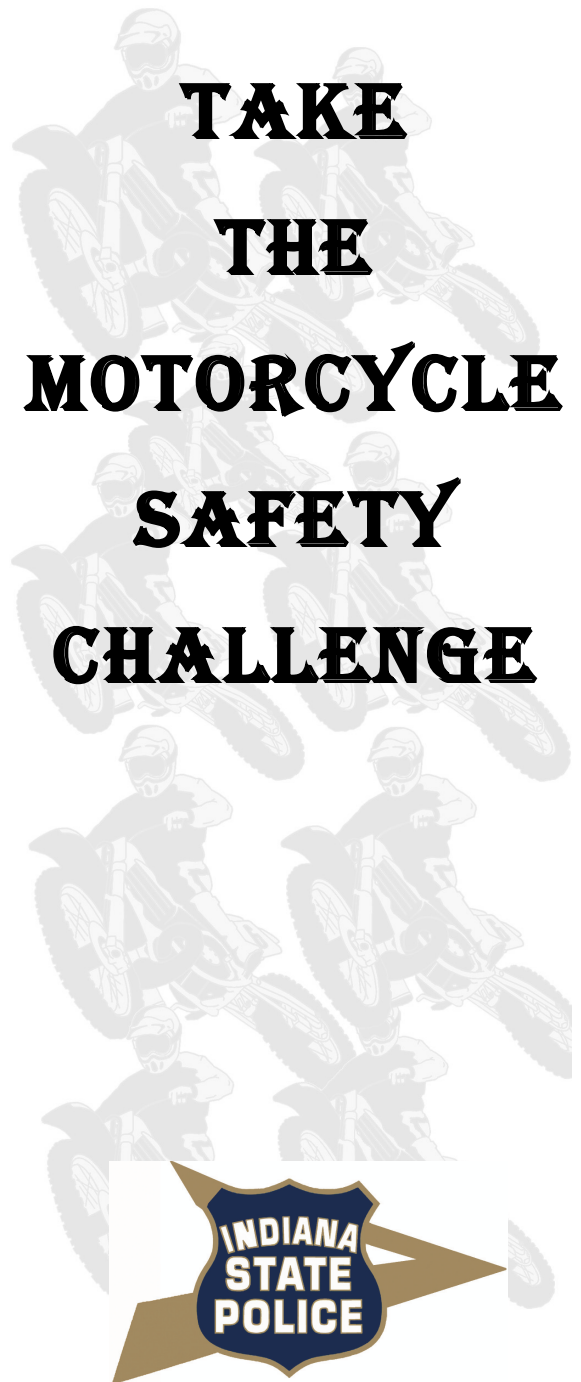

### WHAT IS AN OFF-ROAD OR ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ?

~An ATV is a motor driven vehicle, which can travel cross-country over natural ground without a road or trail.

### WHO CAN DRIVE AN ATV ?

~A person under the age of 14 shall not operate a vehicle without immediate supervision of a person 18 years or older except on land owned or controlled by a parent or guardian, thus anyone over 14 can drive an ATV.

### WHERE ARE ATVs NOT ALLOWED TO BE OPERATED ?

~ATVs shall not be operated on a public highway, street, right-of-way or parking lot.  
~These vehicles cannot be used to hunt or pursue domestic or wild animals.

### WHAT ABOUT ATV REGISTRATION ?

~Registration is required for most off-road vehicles.  
~A certificate will be issued which should be available at all times for inspection.  
~Registration numbers must be permanently affixed to the front of the vehicle.

### WHAT IS A MOTORIZED BICYCLE (MOPED) ?

~It is a two or three wheeled automatic transmission vehicle, which may be propelled by an internal combustion engine, which is less than two horsepower and 50 cubic centimeters, or a battery powered motor.

### WHAT IS REQUIRED OF A MOTORIZED BICYCLE DRIVER ?

~He or she must be at least 15 years old and have either an identification card obtained from a Bureau of Motor Vehicles license branch, a valid learner's permit or driver's license, chauffeur's license or a public passenger chauffeur's license.

### HOW IS A MOTORIZED BICYCLE RESTRICTED ?

~Motorized bicycles shall not operate on interstates or sidewalks.  
~They shall not exceed a speed of 25 miles per hour.  
~Drivers or passengers who are less than 18 years of age must wear protective headgear including a helmet and protective glasses, goggles or a transparent face shield.

### DOES A MOTORIZED BICYCLE HAVE TO BE REGISTERED ?

~A motorized bicycle is not required to be registered by the Bureau of Motor Vehicles.

### WHAT IS A MOTORCYCLE ?

A motorcycle is a motor vehicle, excluding a farm tractor or motorized bicycle, with a seat; for the use of a rider and for travel on not more than three wheels.

### HOW CAN SOMEONE BECOME A LICENSED MOTORCYCLE DRIVER ?

#### First, get a Temporary Motorcycle Learner's Permit

~Issued to those over 15 years of age and enrolled in an approved motorcycle driver education course.  
~Valid for one year, under the supervision of a certified instructor until required courses and tests are passed; then only under the supervision of a licensed motorcycle operator who is 18 years of age or older.

#### Or, a Motorcycle Learner's Permit

~Issued to those currently holding a valid operator's chauffeur's, or public passenger chauffeur's license and who have passed the required exams.  
~Valid for one year.

#### Then, a Motorcycle Operator's License

~Available to individuals who have held a motorcycle learner's permit and who have successfully completed required courses and exams.  
~Or, if you successfully pass a motorcycle safety course, you do not have to take the riding test. For course information, call (317)232-0890.  
~Not available to anyone under 16 years and one month of age.



### WHAT ARE THE MOTORCYCLE PASSENGER OR DRIVER RESTRICTIONS ?

~Not more than one passenger is permitted on a regular seat designed for passenger use.  
~Drivers may not carry packages.  
~Passengers or drivers younger than 18 years of age must wear protective headgear and protective glasses or transparent face shields.  
~Headlamps shall be illuminated at all times when motorcycle is in operation.

### DO MOTORCYCLES NEED REGISTRATION ?

~Motorcycles must be registered with the Bureau of Motor Vehicles and must have a license plate (both involve a fee).

### HOW CAN ACCIDENTS BE AVOIDED ?

~Learn properly from an accredited teacher\*  
~Practice on private property.  
~Watch for objects on the road: holes, pedestrians, traffic, etc.  
~Do not follow too closely.  
~Avoid sudden swerving.  
~Watch for loose materials on curves and hills.  
~Practice breaking with both brakes at the same time.  
~Reduce speed on wet pavement or in loose gravel and before curves.  
~ Know how to lay down the motorcycle in case of emergency.  
~Always wear helmet, shield or goggles, long-sleeved jacket\*, sturdy gloves\* and over-the-ankle boots\*.  
~Don't ride if you've been drinking or taking drugs.  
~When carrying loads, fasten them tightly to the rear.  
~Pass with caution.  
~Double check blind entries.  
~Wear brightly colored clothing.  
~Signal clearly.  
~Drive Defensively - It's a matter of life and death.

(\*Specifically applies to motorcycles and ATVs.)
