**BASIC SKILLS POLICIES &
PROCEDURES:**

Skate Rental: Skate Rental is **\$3 per week** for group lesson participants and must be paid directly to the rink each week. If you own your own skates, please feel free to use them at no additional cost.

Practice Times: Learn to Skate classes are not held on a public session and therefore will have a designated practice area. Please be advised that the practice area is strictly for skaters enrolled in the basic skills program only and no other skaters will be permitted on the ice. Due to the fact that family members and friends of lesson participants took advantage of the public skate session immediately following skating lessons on Saturdays without paying admission to the rink, this policy will be strictly enforced.

Missed Classes: We encourage you to make up a missed class if there is another class available **in the current session only- no exceptions.** Prior permission or registration is not required for a make-up class. Please bring your completed form to the instructor on the day of the make –up class.

Refund Policy: Refunds will be given up to the second lesson only, not any time after for any reason. The cost of the first lesson, as well as a \$15 processing fee will be deducted from the total.

Suggested Equipment & Clothing: Please wear only one pair of thin socks and something that is warm and easy to move around in. We suggest that Snowplow Sam skaters wear a bike helmet or stocking hat to protect them if they fall down. All Skaters should wear gloves or mittens when skating.

Spectators: We ask that all individuals watching the lessons observe from the bleachers or the lobby. Our goal is to keep the skaters focused on the lesson and the skills they are learning.

Testing: All Skaters will be tested on their final day of class. Skaters are tested to a standard, not compared to each other, and must master each skill before advancing to the next level.

Private Lessons: Private lessons may be conducted on public skate sessions or Winter Club of Indianapolis freestyle sessions at the Pepsi Coliseum. Private lessons are not included in the cost of the session and funds will be paid directly to the instructor. Ice Fees will also apply and will be paid directly to the rink for public skate sessions or to Winter Club of Indianapolis for freestyle sessions.
